Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	<ul> <li>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</li> <li>Social Security number and account balances</li> <li>credit history and credit scores</li> <li>payment history and transaction or loss history</li> <li>When you are <i>no longer</i> our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</li> </ul>		
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons LorMet Community Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>LorMet Community Federal Credit Union does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</li> </ul>		
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. - Our joint marketing partners include CUNA Mutual Group's MEMBERCONNECT.
